Les Roulants Blanc - £4.6 | £6 | £7.9 | £21

Beautifully fresh, modern wine with notes of citrus and green apple. Ugni blanc, colombard.

Fairway Pinot Grigio - £4.9 | £6.5 | £8.6 | £23

This gem from Northern Italy offers delightful notes of fresh citrus, apple, and orange blossom.

Squealing NZ Sauv Blanc - £5.6 | £7.2 | £9.1 | £26.5

Bursting with flavour, this wine is perfectly crisp and refreshing with tropical fruit flavours or pineapple, passionfruit, and citrus.

Andrew Peace Chardonnay £5.6 | £7.2 | £9.1 | £26.5

A refreshing, rich white wine full of subtle flavours of tropical fruit and delicate citrus.

Vermentino Trulli - £30

Tuscany is world renowned for its red wines, this premium white shows that it's not just a one trick pony. Pear, grapefruit, and spices

Matahiwi Estate Pinot Gris - £34

Classic Pinot Gris on the nose, with pure aromas of melon, pears and citrus zest.

Alain Geoffroy Chablis - £41

The nose is rich and ripe, first full of flowers then going on to reveal its fruity aromas.

Sancerre, Gitton Pere et Fils - £43

A nose of nettles and grass leads to cool gooseberry flavours and a smoky herbal twist – a fine expression of Sancerre from this family-owned domain.

Ropiteau Puligny-Montrachet 2015 - £71

Ropiteau have been perfecting their Montrachet since 1848, using traditional methods of vinification in their ancient cellars.

Sparkling

Chio Prosecco - £7.2 | £24

Fresh fruity aromas. Citrus and green fruit on the palate.
A truly pleasant finish

Sparkling Rosé - £8 | £29

A blend of Pinot Noir and Glera, the grape used in Prosecco, this is full of delicate red fruit flavours and soft frothy bubbles.

Les Roulants Rose - 4.6 | £6 | £7.90 | £21

Pale pink, light and bright with fresh zingy fruit flavours

Pier 42 Rosé - £4.9 | £6.5 | £8.6 | £23.5

Light Pink-coppery colour, a crisp and intense aroma, as well as harmonious and fruity taste with notes of peach

Canyon Road Zinfandel - £4.6 | £6 | £7.9 | £21

This sweet Californian is smooth and crisp, hints of strawberry, cherry, and watermelon.

Diamarnie Coteaux Varioz en Provence Rose - £34

Pale pink and very expressive on the nose, delightful tangy on the palate with fresh fruit and citrus aromas leading to an elegant dry finish.

Dessert Wine

Botrytis Semillon Deen de Bortoli - £25 (37.5cl) £7.5 (125ml)

Classic botrytis characters of dries Apricots and Marmalade are supported by a touch of Vanilla Oak in this Luscious wine from the Riverina.

Champagne

Champagne Gruet Brut Selection - £51

Elegant, light, and fresh, with exquisite fruit aromas and a slightly lemony nose. A pleasing lively mousse and a splendid crisp finish.

Red

Les Roulant Rouge - £4.6 | £6 | £7.9 | £21

A pleasing blend of Carignan and Merlot, good structure, and a hint of spice and full of fruit.

Merlot Norte Chico- £4.9 | £6.5 | £8.5 | £23

An exceptionally soft and easy-drinking merlot with vibrant red berry aromas, ripe plum flavours, and a hint of chocolate.

7 Fires Malbec - £5 | £6.6 | £8.5 | £23.5

This delicious Argentine Malbec has notes of luscious blackberry, cherry and plum, complimented by subtle hints of violet and sweet spice on the silky-smooth palate.

Shiraz Riddle Andrew Peace- £5.2 | £6.9 | £8.9 | £25

Rich, smooth and full bodied a touch of Tempranillo is added to the blend, giving the wine ripe black fruit flavours and a hint of cherry.

Cotes du Rhone, Prieurs de st Julein - £26.5

Appealing aromas of hedgerow fruit and violets, before a concentrated palate of blackberry, damson and plum with a peppery edge on the finish.

Domaine De Lambisque les Vignes Sauvages - £27.50

Lovely deep ruby red hue, with purplish tints. Elegant on the nose characterised by red and black fruit, spices and garrigue scrubland fragrances.

Rioja Cosecha, Finca Manzanos - £28.50

Vibrant fruit with hints of oak - classical brightness and structure give way to a long smooth finish.

Primitivo Appassimento Lucale - £31

An intense garnet colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherry, raspberry, and redcurrant, full-bodied and supple, with layers of dark fruit, fine tannin, and a lingering finish.

Regional Reserve YV Pinot Noir - £35

Perfumed and complex, with red fruit aromas and hints of spice and Smokey oak. Gentle tannins with dark fruit flavours.

Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Cantine di Negrar - £53

A generous, classical Amarone with impressive concentration and texture.

Gevrey Chambertin, Nuiton-Beaunoy. £60

Dense and well-structured with pleasant minerality, berry fruit flavours with a hint of toast.
